Prices listed are estimates only.
2. Closing date for this sale is Tuesday, February 4, 2014 at 5:00 P.M. (EST). Email and FAX bids will also be accepted until that time. Tie bids will be awarded to the earliest bid received. Bids received after the closing time will not be honored.
3. Bidders who are unknown to us are requested to supply two trade references prior to the sale or submit a deposit equal to twenty-five percent (25%) of their total bid.
4. A fifteen percent (15%) Buyer's Fee will be added to each lot won. **A packing charge of seventy-five cents per lot (minimum \$3.00) plus shipping charges will be added.**
5. TERMS: Cash or check, payable in U.S. funds. Payment is due upon notification of successful bids. A late charge of \$1.50 per month will be added to all invoices over 30 days. Title to all lots remains with Lake Books until paid for in full. Delivery may be postponed until full payment is received, at the discretion of the cataloger. **Make checks payable to Fred L. Lake.**
