1. This is an unrestricted mail bid sale. All lots will be sold to the highest bidder. Enter your bid by lot number. Please feel free to bid as much as you wish on each lot, with the realization that all bids will be treated as limits and all lots will be sold below those bids as competition dictates. **Bids that include cents will be rounded up to the nearest half-dollar.** Bids that are not entered in good faith or are deemed to be totally ridiculous will be refused at the cataloger's discretion. Prices listed are estimates only.
2. Closing date for this sale is Tuesday, May 6, 2014 at 5:00 P.M. (EDT). Email and FAX bids will also be accepted until that time. Tie bids will be awarded to the earliest bid received. Bids received after the closing time will not be honored.
3. Bidders who are unknown to us are requested to supply two trade references prior to the sale or submit a deposit equal to twenty-five percent (25%) of their total bid.
4. A fifteen percent (15%) Buyer's Fee will be added to each lot won. **A packing charge of seventy-five cents per lot (minimum \$3.00) plus shipping charges will be added.**
5. TERMS: Cash or check, payable in U.S. funds. Payment is due upon notification of successful bids. A late charge of \$1.50 per month will be added to all invoices over 30 days. Title to all lots remains with Lake Books until paid for in full. Delivery may be postponed until full payment is received, at the discretion of the cataloger. **Make checks payable to Fred L. Lake.**
